Regarding Receipt of the Interim Report on the Accumulated Water Containing Radioactive Materials Found in the Trench at Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station

On December 19, 2012, the Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) directed Tokyo Electric Power Co., Inc. (TEPCO) to submit a report on consideration of the water stoppage measures, formulation of patrolling and visual inspection plan, investigation of causes, and establishment of recurrence prevention measures, regarding the accumulated water containing radioactive materials in the trench at Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station (already notified on December 19, 2011).

This is to inform the public that NISA received an interim report on this issue from TEPCO, today, on January 6, 2012. NISA will verify the implementation status of the measures based on the contents of the final reports from TEPCO which will be submitted later.
