Regarding the State of Storage and Treatment of Accumulated Water  
containing High Concentration of Radioactive Materials at Fukushima  
Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station, Tokyo Electric Power Co., Inc.  
(31<sup>st</sup> Report)

The Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) requested Tokyo Electric Power Co., Inc. (TEPCO) to submit a report promptly on the conditions for storage and treatment of the contaminated water and the future outlook in consideration of the conditions in Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station of TEPCO, after beginning the operation of the treatment facilities for the contaminated water (as announced on June 9, 2011).

This is to inform the public that today (January 25, 2011) NISA received the 31<sup>st</sup> report from TEPCO.
